

Do you wonder about your child's development?



All children grow and change at different rates. A developmental screening can let you know if your child is on track.

The Ages & Stages Questionnaire (ASQ-3™) is a quick and easy screening that helps you learn more about your child's development from one month to five years old.

- You can partner with your child care or healthcare provider to regularly screen your child with the ASQ-3™. **You provide the answers about your child because you know your child better than anyone else.**
- Your answers will show your child's strengths and sometimes some developmental concerns. If there are concerns, your ASQ-3™ provider will refer you to someone who can help. You can also call Wisconsin First Step at 1-800-642-7837 for more information.

Parents who use the ASQ-3™ say they learn a lot about their child's growth and development, and they find new ways to play and bond with their children. And screening is fun for your child!

- There are also supportive activities that you and your child care provider can do to help your child's development. Your ASQ-3™ provider will share these with you.

Where can I get an ASQ-3™ for my child?

- Ask your doctor, child care provider, or home visitor if they offer the ASQ-3™ or other developmental screening for your child, or
