

Department of Administration Services and County Executive review departmental budget requests.

AUGUST 15

Department of Administration Services submits summary of requested budgets to the County Board.

SEPTEMBER 25

County Executive presents the Recommended Budget to the County Board.

The Recommended Budget is referred to the Board's Committee on Finance, Personnel & Audit for review.

OCTOBER 1 to 1st week in NOVEMBER

The Committee on Finance, Personnel & Audit reviews the Recommended Budget. A notice is published in local daily newspapers summarizing the Recommended Budget and announcing the annual public hearing on the County Budget.

NOVEMBER - 1st Monday of the Month

Monday, November 3 - 6:30 p.m. County Board Public Hearing on budget.

1st Tuesday after 2nd Monday in NOVEMBER

Monday, November 10 - 8:30 a.m.

County Board annual meeting and the adoption of the budget and tax levy.

During this meeting, the County Board acts on the amendments by the Finance, Personnel & Audit Committee to the County Executive's Recommended Budget as well as amendments submitted by individual County Board members.

NOVEMBER 19

The County Board meets at 1:30 p.m. on November 19, 2014, to consider any possible vetoes by the Executive.

JANUARY 1

Departments begin utilizing budget to provide public services.
